The Entrance The base of the monument lays on a double stair-step: the first with an height of 15 cm and a width of one meter is made of cobbles and presents a barrier made of iron and mullions of granite which delimitate the second stair-step of cobbles.

The **Monument to Fallen in War** dominates Place Risorgimento at the exit of the Peer. It is a bronze group made by the sculptor of Milan Angelo Galli. This group represents with 5 statues of fighters, the main steps of the Italian Unifications (the 3 Italian Wars of Independence, the Capture of Rome and the First World War). The group of statues lays on a high double stair-step base made of granite. It was celebrated on the 18th . March of 1923; in 1945 a plaque was added in order to remember the dead of the Second World War together with an inscription of the poet of Chiavenna Giovanni Bertacchi. In 1986 the monument was restored to remind the fighter of Cernobbio, Gianni Baccarini, fighter of the World War.
