DESCRIPTION

The ancient centre of St. Andrew owes its name to a medieval church dedicated to this Saint and celebrated by the clergyman of St. Michael of Rovenna. In 1442 the bishop of Como, Gerardo Landriano, recognized a group of women, who retired in order to pray, as monastic community under the rule of St. Augustine . The monastery was aggregated to the one of S. Peter in the vineyard, tumbled down, and then its tracks were lost. On the wall of the houses there are still devotion signs: in a niche at the number 44 stands out a fresco painted again with *St. Andrew* (called "*al Portello*") and in the background stands out a lake landscape which reminds more the first basin of the Lake of Como than the one of Tiberade.
